CVMA Membership:

If you are a combat veteran who is serving, or who has served, in the United States Armed Forces and ride a motorcycle you could be eligible for membership with the CVMA. If you were active duty, reserve, or National Guard and you were deployed to a combat Theater of operations; you qualify for membership with the CVMA. You must own, operate and carry current insurance on a motorcycle of 30.50 cubic inches (500cc) or above. Veterans, Active duty, reserve, and National Guard personnel must show proof of Combat military service or deployment, on official DOD stationary or forms, by:

Veterans:

- DD 214

Active Duty/Reserve/National Guard:

- Documentation by name.
- Orders (no codes, in English).
- Army: ORB/ERB (2-1).
- Marine Corps/Navy: Page 4.
- Air Force: Award Data Record Page.
- Coast Guard: PDR Award Page.

You will need to read the National & State By-Laws and CVMA Protocol 101 before you fill out and sign the application. Once your application is complete you need to attach the proper paperwork (a **copy** of your DD214, or the documentation listed under Active Duty/Reserve/National Guard) and a check for \$20.00 made out to the CVMA to the AZ State Representative at:

Once the State Rep receives your application he will sign off that he has reviewed your packet and that you meet the qualifications for membership with the CVMA. The State Rep will then forward your packet to "Bulldog", the National Secretary, for final approval. Once approved by the NBOD you will be assigned a CVMA # and Membership card, which will be presented to you at a chapter meeting. You can then purchase your Full Member (FM) back patch from the State Quartermaster, Dave "Red Baron" Casey. The FM Back patch is \$49; AUX Back Patches are \$46. CVMA By-Laws allow each member to have two (2) FM or AUX Back Patches. Chapter affiliation patches also need to be purchased from the State Quartermaster. The approval process can take anywhere from a few weeks to a few months, depending on how many new members the National Secretary receives that month. So please be patient. In the meantime, you are encouraged to attend any ride and/or meetings that are occurring with your local Chapter.
